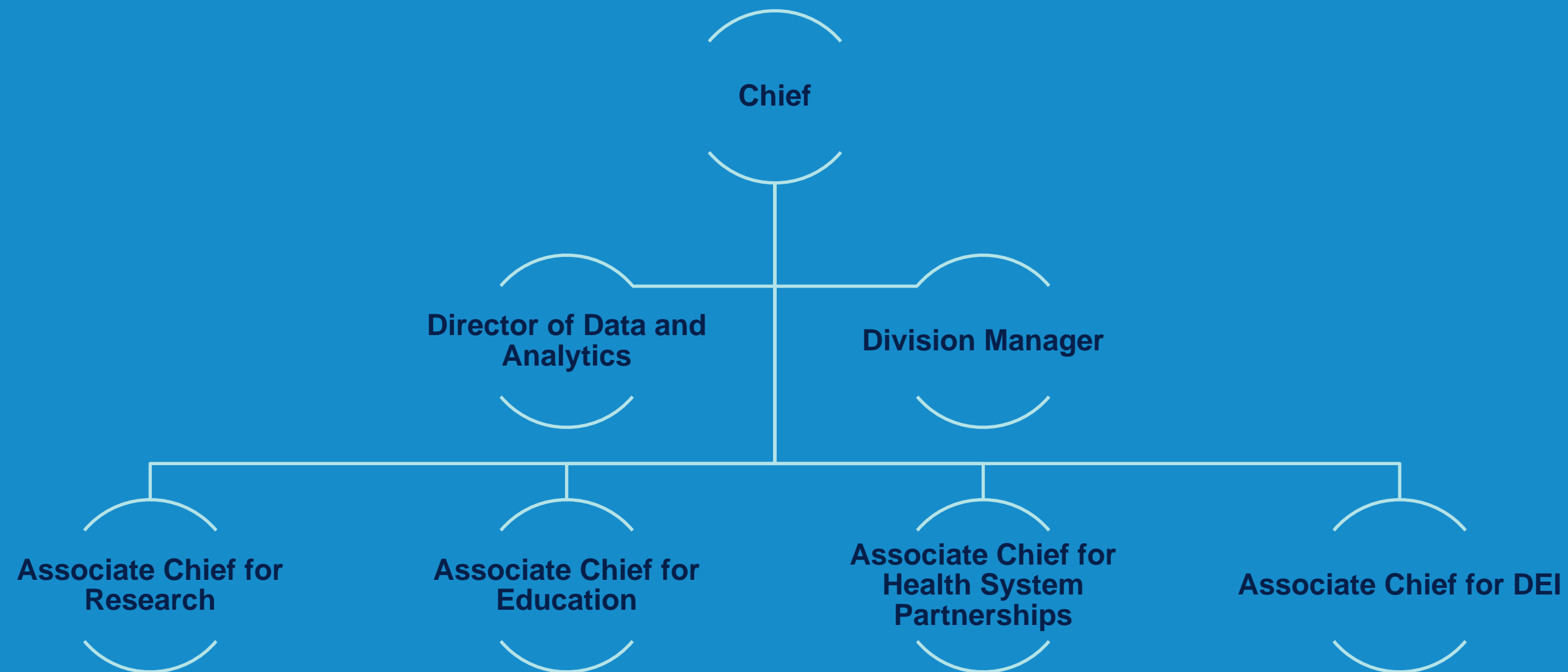

Strategic Plan Area: Research – Expand and Improve Clinical Informatics Research

This includes a focus on:

- Supporting research efforts within the division
- Facilitating research collaborations within the division, across UCSF, and across institutions
- Ensuring research visibility locally, nationally, and internationally
- Developing research-related events and programming for DoC-IT

Associate Chief for Research

In the division, you can come to me:

- To **collaborate** on informatics-related research projects and discuss who to go to and how to access needed expertise
- For **ideas or mentorship** on how to accomplish your research goals
- If you have **recommendations for research-focused divisional programming** (e.g., events, talks, works in progress sessions) or resources

This includes a focus on:

- Supporting current and future education and training programs in the division
- Partnering with DOM and other departments and schools to support their needs in informatics education

- Helping trainees find jobs and become leaders upon graduation

Strategic Plan Area: Health System Partnership – Establish DoC-IT/health system partnership model that creates value for the health system by leveraging DoC-IT's unique capabilities

This includes a focus on:

- Bringing implementation science to health system technology implementation
- Evaluating value for major technology implementations
- Partnering with UCSF Health to establish best practices and infrastructure for evaluating and monitoring emerging technologies, beginning with AI
